A MILESTONE IN ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE: NIILM UNIVERSITY HOSTS NATIONAL SEMINAR ON INDIGENOUS KNOWLEDGE & SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

30-31 OCTOBER, 2025: 260 RESEARCH SCHOLARS PARTICIPATE IN AICTE-SPONSORED TWO-DAY EVENT

NIILM University, Kaithal, inaugurated a prestigious Two-Day National Seminar sponsored by AICTE on the theme "Indigenous Knowledge Systems and Recent Advances in Science, Management, Engineering & Technology for Sustainable Development."
