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KAITHAL

LAND OF HISTORICAL PANORAMA

According to Purana, **Lord Hanuman** was also born in **Kaithal**. The great '**Tilla of Anjani**' is also situated here which is named after his mother Anjani. The local people assassinated Razia Begum, the daughter of Eltutmus alongwith her husband on October 13, 1240. The Tomb of Rajia Begam is still found here.

Kaithal was part of the Karnla District at the time of Haryana State formation. Later Kaithal became the part of the Kurukshetra District. On November 01, 1989, it became the headquarter of the Kaithal District of Haryana. Kaithal has only three and half hours drive from the National Capital.

It is located near the Bidkian Lake, and was an important town during Akbar's rule. The town is said to have been founded by Yudhishtira in celebration of the Pandavas' victory in the Mahabharata. It was first known as Kapisthala, or Abode of Monkeys, and is the birth place of the monkeys' God 'Hanuman'. A temple in memory of Hanuman's mother 'Anjana', is built here.

Kaithal has many colleges and schools which are imparting world class education to the students of Kaithal District area. The NIILM Education Trust has established the NIILM University in Kaithal. This is a major landmark in the education sector of the Kaithal District. The international feel, well developed infrastructure and the quality of education, all contribute to the academic excellence of the University. It is believed that in the coming years the University will contribute in a big way to the growth and development of not only Kaithal, but the entire state. At present, Kaithal is a flourishing town known for its cotton and rice plantation. All modern facilities and amenities are available in the city. It has malls and multiples that form a hub for youth, both for education and recreation.

HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

THE SITE OF BATTLE BETWEEN RAJIA SULTAN AND DELHI FORCES

A fierce battle between Razia Sultan (Iltutmish's Successor) and the rebel forces of Delhi, was fought here. She is said to be buried here, although her tomb is also a mosque near her tomb. The Emperor Akbar renovated this town and built a fort, and after the third battle of Panipat the region came under the rule of Bhai Desu Singh, a Sikh leader, whose palace has now no been converted into a police station and overlooks the lake.

THE MAIN ATTRACTIONS

The Phelgu tank is a watery and holy site in honour of Rishi Phelgu who meditated here, and the Pundri tank dates back to the Mahabharata period. A few temples are also scattered around, like the Saraswati temple, Kapil Muni Temples and Baba Narayan Das temple. The tombs of Shah Wilayat, Sheik Shihabuddin, Shah Kamal and Bidkiyar Kale itself are worth a look.

BRICK TEMPLES

Going to legend, a king called Shalivahana ruled area is the 7th century AD. He was cursed that he would die during the night, but by a stroke of luck he touched the earth where the temple now stands. The curse was revoked, and the King's happiness knew no boundaries. So he gave orders for five temples to be built, out of which only two stand now.

One of them must have originally stood on a terrace but is now half buried under a mound of earth. Both temples follow the Ajanta-Ellora pattern of rock cut facade. Constructed from carved bricks, the highest point culminated in a shikara (pinnacle) and is joined in a beehive manner.

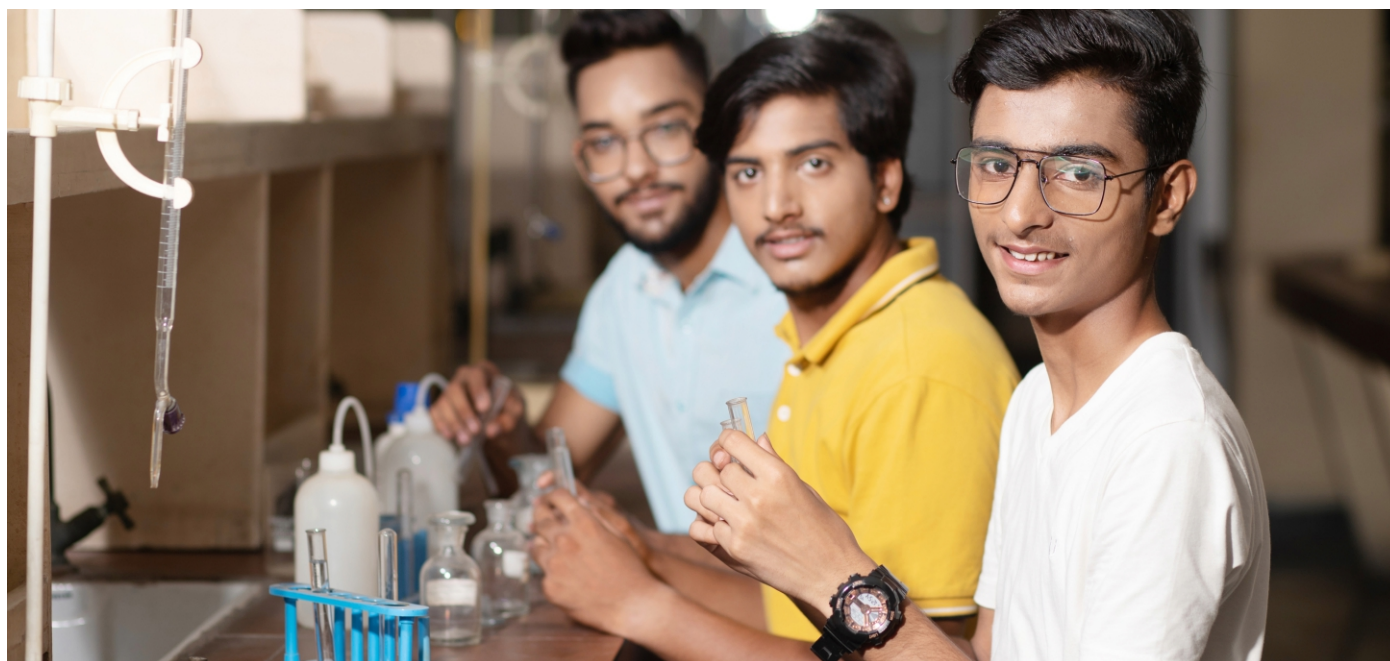


SCHOOL OF BASIC AND APPLIED SCIENCES

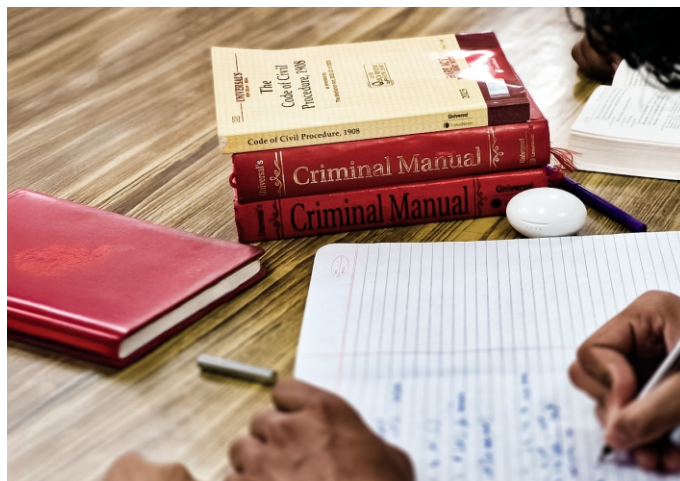

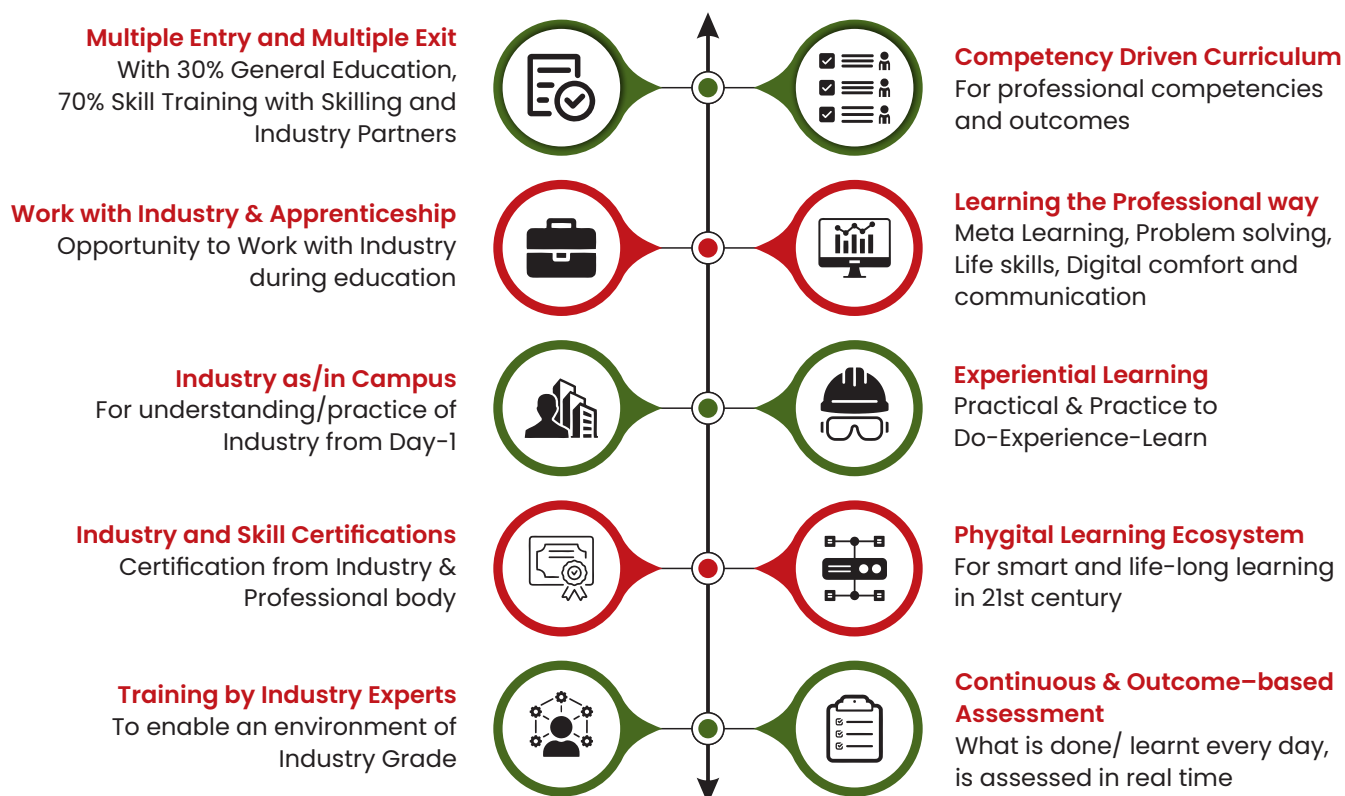

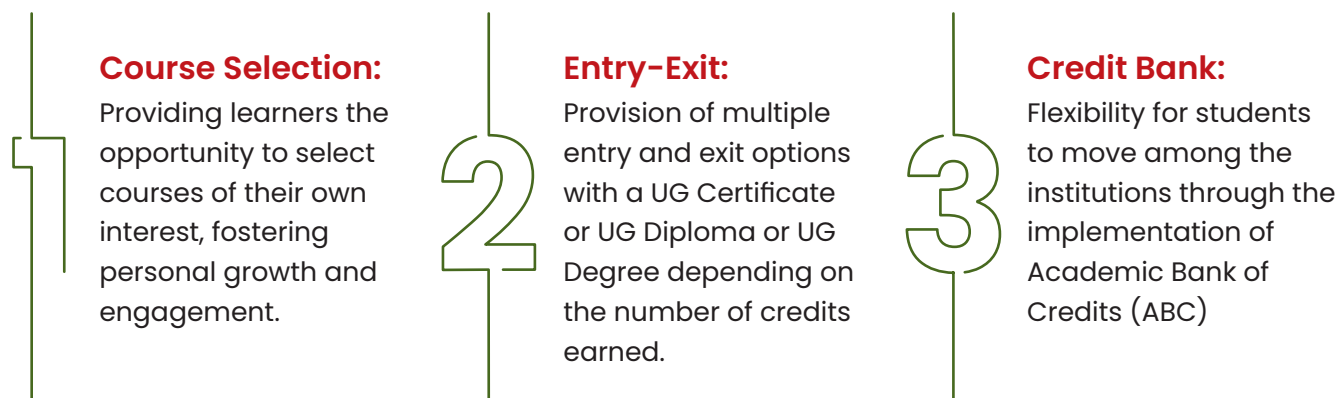

SUBJECTS AND COURSES OF UG PROGRAMMES

The University offers multiple programmes in four categories as per NEP 2020, and NIILM University CCFUGP 2024-25

Category A: Undergraduate Programmes (Multidisciplinary)

A student of UG Programme (Multidisciplinary), herein after called Category-A, will select three subjects A, B and C in the first year out of the pool of subjects in that discipline offered by the Department/School as Major Subjects. Students can choose single major subject from the major subjects studied at 10+2 level or equivalent examination. A student has to secure a minimum of 50% credits from the major discipline for the 3 year or 4 year UG degree to be awarded a single major. For example, in a 3 year UG programme, if the total of credits to be earned is 136, a student of B.Sc. with a minimum of 68 credits in Physics will be awarded B.Sc. in Physical Science with Physics. Similarly, in a 4-year UG programme, if the total number of credits to be earned is 184, a student of Physics with a minimum of 92 credits will be awarded a B.Sc. (Hons. /Hon. with research in Physics in a 4-year UG programme with single major.

Category D: Undergraduate Programmes (Interdisciplinary)

A student of UG Programme (Interdisciplinary), herein after called Category-D, will study three courses of the discipline in each semester as prescribed in the scheme of the concerned programme.

Note: Eligibility for admission to the UG programs will be as per NIILM University CCFUGP 2024-2025

COURSE CATEGORIES

Each discipline offers multiple categories of courses. As per NEP 2020, students have flexibility to choose the courses from the pool of courses.

Major Courses:

It is mandatory core course of 4 credits to be taught in a programme. For example, in B.A. (single major) History, the major course shall be the core course of History. In multidisciplinary courses of study, such as B.Sc. Life Sciences programme, a student shall study major courses of three disciplines from the pool of life sciences.

Minor Courses (MIC):

MIC helps a student to gain a broader understanding beyond the major discipline. A student may choose a course of study from the pool of courses different from the major subjects. It includes vocational courses also. These courses are 2/4 credits.

Multidisciplinary Courses (MDC):

All UG students are required to undergo 3 introductory-level courses relating to any of the broad disciplines of 3 credits each. These courses are intended to broaden the intellectual experience and form part of liberal arts and science education. Students are not allowed to choose or repeat courses already undergone at the higher secondary level (12th class) in the proposed major and minor stream under this category.

It is compulsory for all UG programmes to complete 8 credits of Ability Enhancement course (AEC), 9 credits of Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) & 6-8 credits of Value Added Course (VAC).

Note: Students are advised to coordinate with their departments for the detailed programs, assessment and examination framework. The pool of courses are provided at the university website (<https://www.niilmuniversity.ac.in>)

INTERNSHIP & RESEARCH PROJECT



Internship

Internship is a course to develop a professional ability through an appropriate learning. The internship is of 4 credits.



Research Project

Research project is a course involving applications of knowledge in exploring, analyzing and solving real life situations/ problems.

PG CURRICULUM AND CREDIT FRAMEWORK: HIGHLIGHTS

The University follow the Scheme of Studies as per the recommendations of NEP 2020, adopted from the academic session 2024-25. There is 2-year PG programme with the second year devoted entirely to research for those who have completed the 3-year Bachelor's programme. For students completing a 4-year Bachelor's programme with Honours/Honours with Research, there is a 1-year PG programme. The University offers an integrated 5-year Bachelor's/Master's programme also.

FEATURES OF THE PROGRAMME:

Discipline Shift:

Flexibility to move from one discipline of study to another.

Major-Minor:

Flexibility for students who qualify UG with a major and minor(s) to opt for either major or minor(s) subject or any other subject if they are able to prove their competence in PG programme.

Course Choice:

Opportunity for learners to choose the courses of their interest.

Academic Mobility:

Mobility and flexibility as per the UGC (Establishment and Operation of Academic Bank of Credits in Higher Education) Regulations, 2021, and UGC Guidelines for Multiple Entry and Exit in Academic Programmes offered in Higher Education Institutions.

- ❑ The course structure for each semester will be composed of 22 to 26 credits, the number credits may vary as per discipline. For council programs, the core course structure will be as per council guidelines, however elective, skill, MOOC and seminars will be added as per University Curriculum Framework.
- ❑ Each department will offer one course on Skill Enhancement as EEC (Employability & Entrepreneurship Course) of 2 credits or Value Added Course of 2 credits in 2nd Semester on “Employability and Entrepreneurship Skills”. If EEC is added is offered in 2nd Semester then Value Added Course will be integrated in Academic Activities of the Department or if Value Added Course is offered in 2nd Semester then EEC will be integrated in Academic Activities of the Department.
- ❑ A summer internship of 4 credits of 4–6 weeks duration or equivalent course on employability practical skills (discipline specific)/ research aptitude or department can design one course of 4 credit in place of internship for training the students on employability/ entrepreneurship/ vocational skills/ research aptitude, after 2nd semester for enhancing the employability or developing the research aptitude will be mandatory for all PG students.
- ❑ One course of 2 credits on Research Methodology and one course of 2 credits on Research and Publication Ethics in 3rd semester will be mandatory for all students irrespective of discipline.
- ❑ Each student will opt an open elective course of 2 credits from a pool of courses offered by the Department/ School in 3rd Semester or MOOC from the University Courses/ SWAYAM/ NPTEL or from any other platform recognized by UGC and registered on ABC/ APAAR. Fee for such courses will be paid by student separately.
- ❑ One departmental seminar of 2 credits is mandatory in 4th Semester (for two year PG Program) or 2nd Semester (for one year PG Program) for all students irrespective of their discipline.
- ❑ One course of 2 credits on IPR is mandatory in 4th semester (for two year PG Program) or 1st Semester (for one year PG Program) for all students irrespective of discipline.

GUIDELINES FOR VARIOUS RESEARCH PROGRAMS

Ph.D Courses

The degree of Ph.D. may be awarded in the various courses of the different departments.

Eligibility:

A candidates seeking admission to the course of Ph.D. must fulfil the following relevant academic criteria:

1. A 1-year/ 2-Semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/ 8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/ 4- semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree program or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale whichever grading system is followed

or

equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority; established or incorporated under a law in it's home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institutions.

2. Candidates who has completed the M.Phil. programme with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale whichever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit, or assure quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme.

A relaxation of 5% marks or equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ ST/ OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories candidates as per the decision of the commission time to time.

It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure his/her eligibility and fulfilment of such other condition (s) as may be prescribed for admission in the rules and regulations of the University. The admission to Ph.D. course will be in order of merit and subject to availability of seat (s) and expert (s) for guidance/ supervision in the area of research. Before submission of Application Form, the candidate is required to ascertain these facts from the concerned Department/Institute. Merely qualifying the entrance test will not ipso-facto entitle a candidate to get himself/herself enrolled for Ph.D. course in the concerned Department/Institute.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE IN Ph.D

The University shall admit Ph.D. Scholars through a National Eligibility Test (NET) Score, or an Entrance test conducted at the level of university for the applicant not appeared for NET.

Shortlisted candidates will be called for written examination and interview. Admission to Ph.D. Program will be based on the overall performance in Post Graduate Degree, Entrance Examination and Personal Interview.

Duration of Programme

Ph.D. program shall be for a minimum duration of three years, including course work and a maximum of six years, the period shall be counted from the date of issue of provisional enrollment letter.

Credit Layout of Ph.D. Course Work

- The coursework shall be treated as a prerequisite for Ph.D. In the first year of registration, all research scholars are required to complete the course work for one semester following their provisional registration as a part of the Ph.D. program. It is mandatory to complete the course work in first 4 semesters to stay in the Ph.D. program.
- It is mandatory to complete a 12 credit coursework according to the following distribution.

- Candidates who already hold an M. Phil. degree and have been accepted into the Ph.D. program, or those who have finished their M.Phil. coursework and have been given permission to continue on to the Ph.D. in an integrated course, may be exempted from the Ph.D. course requirements by the Department. All additional applicants accepted into the Ph.D. program must complete the Ph.D. coursework required by the Department.
- The NIILM University attendance rules, a minimum 75% attendance is must require, will be applied to all full-time research scholars.
- A Ph.D. scholar has to obtain a minimum of 55% of marks or a minimum CGPA of 6.0 in the UGC 10-point scale (or an equivalent grade/CGPA in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the course work in order to be eligible to continue in the programme and submit the thesis.

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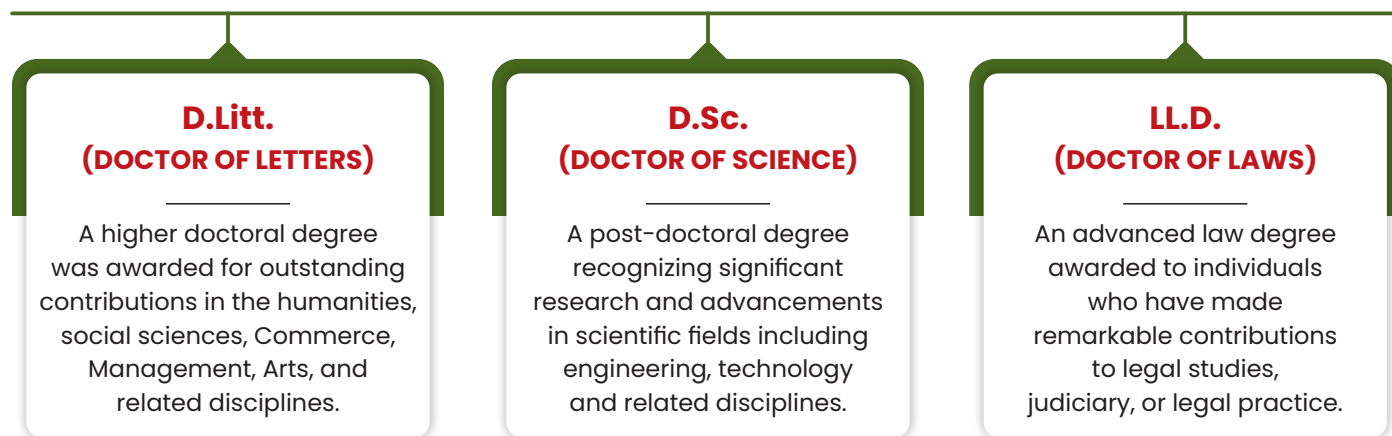

- ☐ A minimum of 10 publications in Scopus, Web of Science, SCI, UGC Care, or other reputed journals is essential.

PLEASE NOTE

The publication requirement may be relaxed for candidates with at least two published patents or books, along with expert recommendations and proven societal or academic impact.

Application Process

Candidates must submit their application to the University's R&D Cell with the following:

Program Modes:

- ☐ **Full-Time:** Scholars must work full-time at the University.
- ☐ **Part-Time:** Open to permanent faculty/professionals; requires NOC from employer and access to research facilities at their workplace.

Note: 25% supernumerary seats are reserved for international students.

Evaluation & Selection Process:

- ☐ Applications and supporting documents are reviewed by a panel of experts constituted by the R&D Cell and approved by the Vice Chancellor.
- ☐ Shortlisted candidates may be invited to present their work before the RDC/Interview Board.
- ☐ The committee evaluates the originality, impact, and significance of the applicant's contributions.
- ☐ Final selection is made by the University's Research Advisory Council based on expert recommendations.
- ☐ Selected candidates are formally registered into the Post-Doctoral Program.
- ☐ The University reserves the right to reject any application without assigning reasons.

Duration of the Program and Research Progress:

- ☐ The duration of the post-doctoral program shall be a minimum of one year and a maximum of three years.
- ☐ An extension beyond three years may be granted under exceptional circumstances, subject to approval by the RDC.

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

1. Admission of students shall be made strictly based on merit based on University Entrance Test or CUET Score.
2. Only such candidates who have passed a qualifying examination from an Indian University/ Board established or recognized by the State/Central Government or such other examination as has been recognized equivalent by the State/Central Government/ University shall be considered for admission
3. Admissions to the various Diplomas, UG, PG & Ph.D. programs of studies will be made by the school wise Admission Committee and two members nominated by the Registrar.
4. Minimum qualifications for admission to the programs in various Departments have been prescribed and are available in the information brochure as well as on the University website.
5. The University shall follow the reservation policy prescribed by the Govt. of Haryana for private universities admissions.
6. If, at any time, it is discovered that a candidate has provided false or incorrect information or has used fraudulent means for securing admission, his/her admission shall be canceled
7. The student shall deposit fees as prescribed by the University, on or before the due date prescribed by the University.
8. Commencement of Semester/year starts from the First week of July for the Odd semester and December for the even semester every year or as per notification of UGC.
9. The student would be liable for necessary action as deemed fit by the University for any wrong/false/incomplete/fraud information filled in the application form by him/her and his/her admission shall be canceled and all fees and other dues paid by him/her will be forfeited. The University may also take further strict legal action as deemed fit against such candidates.
10. A student shall also be eligible for admission to any program of study of this University on migration from any other University or Board if she/he has passed an examination equivalent to the examination of this University prescribed by the admission policy to the concerned program of this University. For transfer of credits please refer to Ordinance (Transfer of Credits) of the University.
11. Each candidate shall submit the following Affidavits/Declaration-cum-Undertaking in the format given in the information brochure:
 - i. Anti-Ragging Undertaking by the student.
 - ii. Anti-Ragging Undertaking by the parent/guardian.
 - iii. Declaration-cum-Undertaking by the parent/guardian/student.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Late Admission

Late admissions may be accepted purely at the discretion of the Vice-Chancellor subject to fulfillment of the guidelines as prescribed by the Regulatory Bodies from time to time.

Mode of Fee Payment

1. A candidate who is offered provisional admission by the Admission Cell/ Counselors shall submit the application form duly completed in all respects to the Registration Branch and shall deposit the course fee with the Account Branch so that registration formalities can be completed
2. Students must obtain the receipt for every payment made to the university and deposit one copy to the respective student section.
3. Fee shall not be accepted in part or in installments unless specifically allowed by the competent authority of the University.
4. Delayed payments will attract late fee charges
 - i. 15 days or less after the due date of fee submission Rs. 50/- Per Day
 - ii. 16 days to 30 days after the due date of fee submission Rs. 100/- Per Day
 - iii. 31 days to 45 days after the due date of fee submission Rs. 5000/- Maximum Limit of Late Fee Fine Rs. 5000/-

Note: Maximum Late Fee fine is to be submitted along with the permission of the respective Dean and Admission Committee.

5. Students opting to withdraw his/her admission will be entitled to a refund of the fee as per the Refund Policy notified by UGC.
6. The last date for admission in any program will be as notified by the University and state government.

RESERVATION OF SEATS

As per the provisions of Section 35 of the Haryana Private Universities Act, 2006, 25% of seats in the University shall be reserved for students of the State of Haryana, out of which 10% seats are reserved for the students belonging to Scheduled Castes of the State of Haryana.

ATTENDANCE RULES

It is obligatory on the part of the HoD/Teacher concerned to announce the attendance position of each student at the end of every month in the classes. The students, who are falling short of attendance, are advised to improve their attendance position. However, the students are also advised to get their attendance noted by their concerned HoD/Teachers at the end of every month to avoid their total shortage of attendance at the end of the semester.

1. Every student should get at least 75% attendance or as prescribed by authorities in aggregate in all subjects at the end of each semester/year to be eligible to appear in university examinations.
2. Deficiency up to 5% can be condoned by the Dean/HoD in severe cases on compensatory ground/medical cases students with 70% or above attendance can be eligible to appear in the semester exam if a 5% deficiency is condoned by the Registrar.
3. The students having attendance below 70% are liable to be detained.
4. Detained student will have to repeat the respective academic subjects/semester/year in the next academic session by paying their fee/dues as applicable.

FEE REFUND POLICY

The refund of fees shall be applicable for the following categories:

- As per Government instruction time to time applicable.

1. TUITION FEE REFUND

1. A request for a fee refund may be submitted through a Student Refund Request Form, which shall be available in the Student Interaction Cell.
2. All supporting documents and evidence together refund must be attached
3. The registration fee and entrance examination fee (wherever applicable) are non-refundable.
4. If the withdrawal application is received on or before the start date for classes, a refund will be issued after deductions as outlined in the table below and if the succeeding seat is not filled by another student, there will be no reimbursement of fees.
5. If the admission is terminated owing to non-payment of the remaining tuition fee by the due date specified in the Provisional Admission Letter, or if the student fails to appear at the University without prior notice, the entire money deposited will be forfeited.
6. Any scholarship awarded will not be considered for calculating fees.
7. Any refund request for payment to third-party bank accounts will be turned down.
8. The students who are expelled or whose names are stricken from the roll list due to non-submission of documents, failure to register forth with in the given time period, non-payment of dues, or Any other reason is not entitled for refund. Only the security deposit will be reimbursed after paying any outstanding debts.
9. No interest shall be paid on any fees or deposits refunded.
10. In the event of a disagreement, the Director of Finance's decision will be final and binding.
11. The University reserves the right to modify and amend refund policies every year.
12. All disputes arising out of or in connection with this are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of Kaithal.

As per the Refund Policy notified by UGC in October 2018/July 2023 or amended from time to time, the Competent Authority has approved the University Fee Refund Policy. The refund shall be processed as per the details mentioned below.

- ☐ **Non Resident Indians (NRI):** An Indian citizen who is residing outside India and hold an Indian Passport. Only those Non-Resident Indian students who have studied and passed the qualifying examinations from schools or colleges in foreign countries will be included as international students.

EXAMINATION RULES

1. It is compulsory to bring your Admit card & Identity Card with you.
2. Reach the examination Center at least half an hour before the commencement of the examination; and occupy the seat that bears your Enrollment Number.
3. DO NOT take any kind of ready reckoner to the examination hall.
4. Write your Registration Number, as given in the Admit Card, on the answer sheet & on the question paper also.
5. During the examination, follow the instructions of the invigilator strictly.
6. Hand over your answer sheet to the invigilator before you leave the Examination Hall.

Males and females work together in a congenial atmosphere, however if there are any complaints involving physical contacts or advances, demand for sexual favours, sexually tainted remarks, and any unwelcome physical, verbal or nonverbal expressions of a sexual nature; it is addressed and appropriate action is taken. This cell aims at sensitizing the students and staff to work diligently to prevent sexual harassment in the college. Complaints of sexual harassment shall be lodged with the committee and appropriate disciplinary action is initiated by the members in accordance to the rules and regulations of the University.

ANTI-RAGGING CELL

The Anti-Ragging cell will deal with all disciplinary matters. The Committee shall constantly monitor the behaviour of the students. All disciplinary matters will be placed before the Committee, which will hear the matter and report it to the Governing body, which will take action according to the due process of law. The affected student is required to submit an anti-ragging affidavit as per the UGC notification. Continuous watch and vigil over ragging by university and the University will promptly deal with the incidents of ragging brought to its notice. The University will summarily punish or reprimand the guilty student, either by itself or by following procedures, administrative or otherwise, by constituting a special Enquiry Committee and put forth its findings or recommendations before the competent authority to take a decision. Students are encouraged to report any ragging act witnessed or experienced by them to the university administrators, faculty, Anti-Ragging Cell and Grievance Redressal Cell or any other staff member with whom the student may feel comfortable. The University ensures the confidentiality of such a disclosure by the student.



GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

NIILM UNIVERSITY is committed to providing a safe, fair and harmonious learning and work environment. Grievance Redressal Cell facilitates the resolution of grievances in a fair and impartial manner involving the respective School / Dept. / Office (dealing with the substantive function connected with the grievance), maintaining necessary confidentiality, as the case may be. Any stakeholder with a genuine grievance may approach Grievance Redressal Cell at Centre for Students and Administrative Services (CSAS) to submit his/her grievance in writing or send through e-mail. The objective of the Grievance Cell is to develop a responsive and accountable attitude among all the stakeholders in order to maintain a harmonious educational atmosphere in the university.

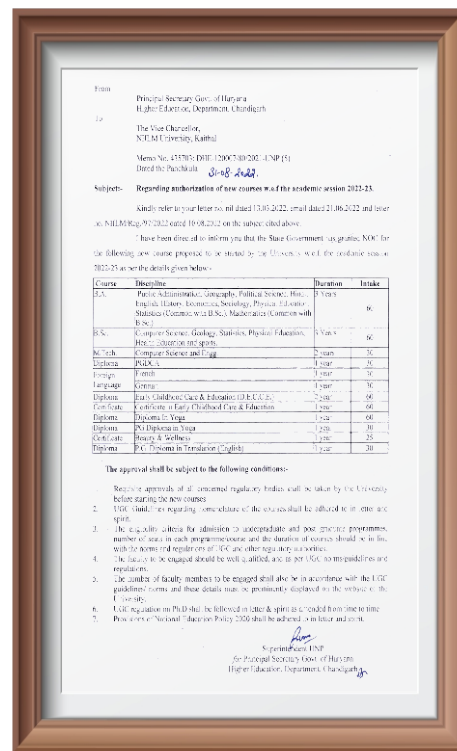
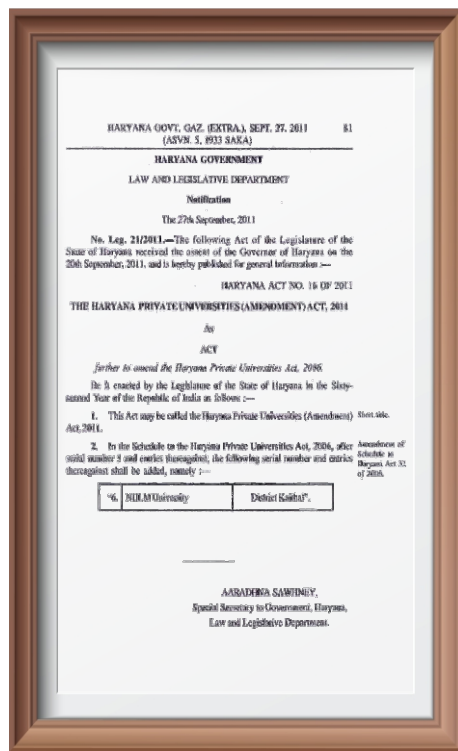
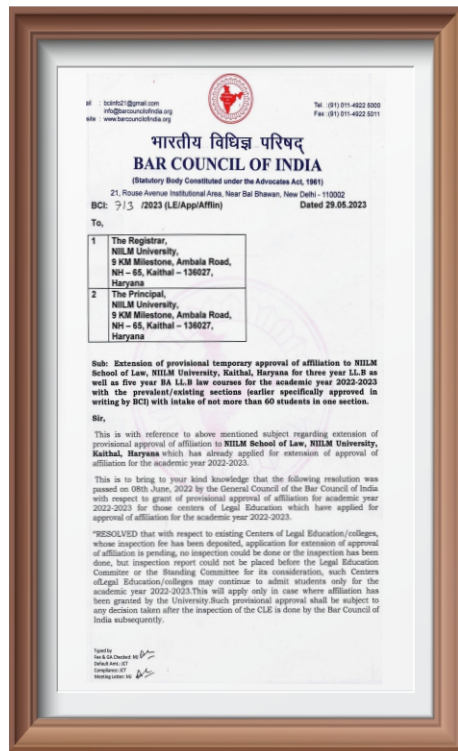

2. In case the University has already started any off campus centre outside the State, it must be closed immediately. It may also be ensured that any off campus centre within the State shall be opened only as per the provision laid down in the UGC (Establishment of and maintenance standards in Private University) Regulation 2003 and with the prior approval of UGC.
3. The University shall not have any affiliated Colleges.
4. The University has to follow UGC (Minimum standards and procedure for award of M.Phil / Ph.D degree) Regulations, 2009.

LIBRARY
